DAY-TO-DAY ITINERARY:

PRETORIA – VICTORIA FALLS

Day 1 Depart Pretoria

At 09h30 depart from Rovos Rail's gracious station in Capital Park Pretoria on a three night four day 1600 kilometre adventure through varied and truly African scenery. Guests may freshen up in their suites before joining fellow travellers in the midway Lounge car or Observation carriage at the rear of the train. Lunch is served while en route to Mafikeng and the Botswana border for border formalities. Enjoy the afternoon relaxing. Dinner is served in the graciously restored dining car/s at 19h30 (Breakfast served 07h00/10h00; Lunch 13h00; Afternoon Tea at 16h30 and Dinner at 19h30)

Day 2

Breakfast is served in the dining car/s from 07h00. Once in Botswana the train heads north through the capital, Gaborone and towards Mahalapye, crossing the Tropic of Capricorn just after Gaborone. Once the train has passed through the dry reaches of Botswana we arrive at Plumtree in the late afternoon for border formalities with Zimbabwe. Lunch and dinner is served in the dining car/s. Overnight stop on the train at Mpopoma.

Day 3

Breakfast is served as the train departs Mpopoma en route to the Hwange National park situation in the east of Zimbabwe. Travelling along the eastern part of the park, guests experience travelling along one of the longest stretches of straight railway line – 114km! 15h00 Arrive at Kennedy Siding for a 15h00 game drive at The Hide.

VICTORIA FALLS - PRETORIA

Day 1 Depart Victoria Falls

This relaxing train journey departs at 17h00 from Victoria Falls, travelling in a south-easterly direction towards the Hwange National Park. Guests may freshen up in their suites before joining other guests in the midway Lounge car or the Observation carriage at the rear of the train. Dinner is served in the dining car/s and the train will have an overnight stop at Kennedy Siding.

Day 2

05h00 rly wake-up call with a light continental breakfast served in the dining car before disembarking at 06h00 for a game drive at The Hide. Brunch served on the train upon return at around 11h00 before departing in a southerly direction towards Plumtree for border formalities from Zimbabwe to Botswana. Dinner is served in the dining car/s.

Day 3

Breakfast will be served in the dining car until 10h00. The train continues the journey via Botswana's capital, Gaborone, to Ramatlabama for border formalities at the border to South Africa. Lunch is served as the train travels through the farmlands of the Marico Valley and dinner is served as the train traverses the Magaliesberg Range. Overnight stop in Krugersdorp.

Dinner is served on the train en route to Thompsons Junction for the overnight stop.

Day 4

Breakfast is enjoyed whilst travelling to the Zambezi River!

10h00 Arrival at Victoria Falls station – End of Journey!

Day 4 Arrive in Pretoria

Today breakfast will only be served until 09h30, as the train is scheduled to arrive at Capital Station in Pretoria at 10h00.

Please note that depending upon railway capacity this journey could be routed northwards through Beitbridge and Zimbabwe.
